| 7 | Can a chapter have virtual and/or in-person voting? | Yes, that is a viable option, based on your chapter's technological capabilities, and as long as the chapter is familiar with the online voting process. One recommendation would be to set up a ballot box ahead of time with the votes to then be counted via a virtual meeting. |

| 8 | Can Boards of small chapters with difficulty recruiting new members be allowed to serve a third term on a case-by-case basis? | If a chapter has the required number of members to serve on the Board, they should discuss the possibility of "switching" roles. For example, the Vice President becomes the President, the Assistant Treasurer becomes the Treasurer, etc. |
| 9 | Will waivers be allowed for President and Treasurer positions? | Waivers will be allowed for officer positions but only in extreme circumstances and for a legitimate reason. The waivers must be submitted in writing to the Metropolis President for her review and consideration. The Metropolis President will forward them with her comments and recommendations to the National Office at elections@philoptochos.org. All waivers will then be forwarded to the National President. The National President shall provide a written response to such requests. As stated in the Bylaws in Article IV: Metropolis Philoptochos Board of Directors, Section 2, Paragraph 5(c), or Article V: Parish Chapter, Section 5, Paragraph 4(c), "no more than one waiver shall be granted where an elected officer seeks to serve a consecutive term in excess of the limitations." |
| 10 | Can elections be delayed? | No, "the chapter board shall be elected at a general meeting, held for this purpose, in the month of May, in the year prior to the National Philoptochos Biennial Convention" as stated in the Bylaws in Article V: Parish Chapter, Section 4, Paragraph 1. <br> There will be no exceptions to this requirement. |
| 11 | How will very small chapters with a total of 5-7 members fill a board? | Very small chapters could allow officers, with the exception of President and Treasurer, to hold more than one position on the board. |
| 12 | Some chapters, where the board is serving a second term, are not planning to hold elections. Is that allowed? | No, this cannot be allowed, under any circumstances. As stated in Article V: Parish Chapter, Section 4, Paragraph 1, "the chapter board shall be elected at a general meeting, held for this purpose, in the month of May, in the year prior to the national Philoptochos Biennial Convention." There will be no exceptions to this requirement. |
