During our meeting the committee shared personal experiences and praised Father Costas Sitaras for the amazing work that he has been doing with the children in his care over the past several years.

- We discussed how we must educate our chapters on the Mission of Saint Basil's Academy and ask them to refer children who may come to their attention through their Social Services program and who may need a safe environment to live in.

National Philoptochos purchases Christmas gifts for all the children at the Academy and personally delivers them to each child at the Annual Christmas Pageant. We receive some beautiful Thank You correspondence from them.

The date of the 2023 Graduation is June 17, 2023. I will be attending and representing our National President, Mrs. Arlene Siavelis Kehl whose other philanthropic and personal and family commitments will not permit her to travel to New York. Gifts will be purchased and will be given, not only to the graduates but also to all the children.

I would also like to also state that National Philoptochos, before the 15th of every month, sends a check for \$30,000.00 to Saint Basil's Academy for the operating expenses of the school. This money comes out of the Vasilopita Fund to which all our chapters so generously donate.
